3. Plug-Ins


- Adobe Reader is required to view PDF files.

4. Browser Functions

2 Common Actions on All Pages

Common header on each page.

1. Common header · · · ①


(1) Top

Clicking [Top] will return you to the home page of the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia Online Access System.

Clicking [Help] will open the PDF user manual in a pop-up window.

You can search for an archive material by entering search keywords and clicking the [Search] button. You can change the number of items to be displayed.

You can change the font size by clicking [S], [M] or [L] button. *Size of the characters in the image will not be changed.

2. Side menu · · · ②

(1) About Using Image Data



Clicking this button will open the PDF file of the guidelines for using images of archive materials.

(2) About the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia



This section introduces the building that stores memorabilia and documents related to Neesima, with photographs of the exterior and interior of the repository and description of the photos.




You can search for memorabilia of Neesima in the repository and download their images.

(4) The Story of Joseph Hardy Neesima



This section contains 20 chapters of Neesima's life presented in a narrative style, each linked to related documents stored in the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia.

Each chapter has the Story Description screen, on which you can read the story as well as view related documents stored in the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia on a separate pop-up window.

(5) The Beginning of Doshisha



This section contains 13 chapters of the history of Doshisha presented in a narrative style, each linked to related documents stored in the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia.

Each chapter has the Story Description screen, on which you can read the story as well as view related documents stored in the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia on a separate pop-up window.

(6) Complete Table of Contents




This page displays the entire list of contents under the "Stories" section of the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia Online Access System. Clicking on the hyperlinked text takes you to the respective content pages.

(7) Short Stories about Joseph Hardy Neesima



This section has 48 articles on Joseph Hardy Neesima and Doshisha. Each article is displayed along with a corresponding image.

(8) A Chronological Biography of Joseph Hardy Neesima



The life of Joseph Hardy Neesima is presented in seven-part chronology. You can have a quick overview of major events in each period of time.

(9) Illustrated Archives



Ten most notable items among the materials related to Joseph Hardy Neesima are each introduced with an illustration.

Illustrations are accompanied by commentary and notes.

(10) Video Archives



The life of Joseph Hardy Neesima is introduced in 10 videos. RealPlayer is required to watch these videos.

(11) Photo Collection

This section collects 72 photographs about Joseph Hardy Neesima, including those of people and buildings related to him.

This section has a collection of writings by Joseph Hardy Neesima translated into modern English.

3 Timeout


The page will time out after 30 minutes of inactivity and you will be unable to perform further actions.

The Repository of Neesima Memorabilia Online Access System is not available for use during the maintenance.



2. Search Function

1 Simplified Search Screen

On the Simplified Search screen you can search for materials of the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia by keyword.

You can search for items that contain the keyword(s) in either "Name", "Author", "Date", "Figure", "Size" or "Catalog No".



1. Open the Simplified Search screen · · · ①



Click [Simplified Search] on the side menu.

2. Enter Keywords · · · ②

Enter keywords that you wish to search for.

- XA fuzzy search of keywords with partial matching is performed.
- *If multiple keywords are entered, an AND search is performed.
- Ex.) If you enter "Doshisha Neesima" in the search box, items that only contain "Doshisha" and not "Neesima" will not be returned.
 - *You can enter up to three keywords, separated by spaces.

An error occurs if four or more keywords are entered.

*Dates should be entered in the order YYYYMMDD.

(Ex: January 11, 2013 should be entered as 20130111.)

3. Change the No. of Display Items · · · ③

You can change the number of items to be displayed on the Result screen.

Choose the number from the drop-down list.

4. Search ··· 4

Click the [Search] button.

The Result screen will be displayed.

If you wish to clear the entered search criteria, click the [Clear] button.

The search criteria is cleared.

2 Search by Catalog Screen

On the Search by Catalog screen, you can search for materials of the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia by catalog category.



1. Open the Search by Catalog screen · · · ①



Click [Search by Catalog] on the side menu.

2. Select Large Categories · · · ②

Select the category you wish to search from the drop-down list.

3. Select Medium Categories · · · ③

Select the category you wish to search from the drop-down list.

XIf the selected large category does not have a medium category, the list is empty.

4. Change the No. of Display Items ••• • 4

You can change the number of items to be displayed on the Result screen.

Choose the number from the drop-down list.

Click the [Search] button.

The Result screen will be displayed.

6. Clear ··· · · 6


If you wish to clear the entered search criteria, click the [Clear] button.

The search criteria is cleared.

3 Search by Condition Screen

On the Search by Condition screen, you can search for materials of the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia by detailed conditions.

If multiple conditions including "Name" and "Author" are specified, an AND search is performed.



1. Open the Search by Condition screen · · · ①



Click [Search by Condition] on the side menu.

2. Enter Name · · · ②

Enter the name of the item you wish to search for.

*A fuzzy search with partial matching is performed.

XIf you enter words in two or more boxes, an OR search will be performed.

3. Enter Author · · · ③

Enter the name of the author you wish to search for.

XA fuzzy search with partial matching is performed.

4. Enter Date · · · ④

Enter the date of issue of the item you wish to search for.

XYou may enter year only, or year and month only. Boxes you did not fill will be auto-completed during search.

Ex.) If you enter "2013" and "February 2014", items dated between January 1, 2013 and February 28, 2014

will be returned.

5. Enter Catalog No. · · · ⑤

Enter the four-digit catalog number of the item you wish to search for.

6. Change the No. of Display Items ••• ⑥

You can change the number of items to be displayed on the Result screen. Choose the number from the drop-down list.

7. Search · · · ⑦

Click the [Search] button.

The Result screen will be displayed.


8. Clear ••• (8)

If you wish to clear the entered search criteria, click the [Clear] button.

The search criteria is cleared.

4 Result Screen


Clicking the search button on the Simplified Search screen, Search by Catalog screen or Search by Condition screen will display items that match the criteria.



1. Keywords···①

Specified search criteria is displayed.

XIf the following message appears:



This message appears when no items matching the search criteria are found. Search again with different criteria.

2. Number of items displayed and total number of matches · · · ②

This bar shows the total number of items matching the search criteria and the number of items currently displayed.

3. Page navigation · · · ③

Links for page navigation appear if the search returns more items than the number of display items set on the search screen.

By clicking these links you jump to the next page or the last page.

4. Information of each item · · · ④

Information of each item matching the search criteria is displayed.

Clicking the [Material Description] button will jump to the Images List screen.

5. Download Images · · · ⑤

Clicking the [Download] button will jump to the Download List screen.



6. Top…6

Clicking this button will return you to the top of the current page.

5 Images List Screen

Clicking the [Material Description] button on the Result screen will show the list of images contained in the material.



1. Information of the material · · · ①

Information of the selected material is displayed.

2. Image and image title · · · ②

Thumbnails of individual images are displayed.

Clicking an image or a hyperlinked image title will open a pop-up window of the Image Description screen, where you can view the enlarged version of the image.

3. Back ⋅ ⋅ ⋅ ③

Clicking the [Back] button will return you to the Result screen.

4. Download Images · · · ④

Clicking the [Download] button will jump to the Download List screen.



5. Top ... ⑤

Clicking this button will return you to the top of the current page.

6 Image Description Screen





1. Close · · · ①

Clicking this will close the current window.

2. Print • • • ②

Clicking this will print the current page.

3. Download · · · ③

Clicking this will download the image.

4. About Using Image Data · · · ④

Clicking this will open the PDF file "About Using Image Data", which is guidelines for using images of archive materials shown on the site.

5. What number the current image is out of the total number of images · · · ⑤

This shows how many images are in the material and what number the current image is. Clicking the right and left arrows will display the previous and next images.

6. Information of the material · · · ⑥

Information of the current image is displayed.

7. High definition image \cdots 7

A high definition image of the archive material is displayed.

XHigh definition images are resized to fit in the window.

8. Top · · · · ⑧

Clicking this button will return you to the top of the current page.

3. Download Function

1 Download Function

Images of archive materials shown on the Repository of Neesima Memorabilia Online Access System are available for download.

1. Download multiple images

Download

Selecting items or images that you wish to download on the Result screen or Images List screen and clicking the [Download] button will direct you to the Download List screen.

Clicking the [Download] button on the Download List screen will start download of the selected images.

2. View image before download

Clicking an image or a hyperlinked image title on the Images List screen will open a pop-up window of the Image Description screen.

Clicking the [Download] button will start download of the displayed image.





2 Result Screen



On the Result screen, you can select items whose images you wish to download.

1. Select an item · · · ①

You can select an item for download by checking the box next to each of them. Checking this box will select all images of the material.

2. Select all items · · · ②

If you wish to select all items displayed on the screen, check the box indicated by ②. XYou cannot make changes to items with the sign "partial select".

3. "partial select" status · · · ③

"Partial select" appears instead of a checkbox if only some of the images of the material are selected. You cannot make changes to the choices for a material indicated "partial select" on this screen. Click the [Material Description] button and change selection on the Images List screen.

4. Proceed to the download list screen · · · ④


After selecting the images, click the [Download] button to jump to the Download List screen.

5. Number of images selected and total file size $\cdot \cdot \cdot \cdot \circ$

This part shows the number of images selected and the total file size.

*The information is as of the point the current screen was displayed. Changes made on the current screen are not included.

3 Images List Screen



You can select individual images of a material on the Images List screen.

1. Select an image · · · ①

You can select an image for download by checking the box under it.

2. Back • • • ②

Clicking the [Back] button will return you to the Result screen.

3. Proceed to the Download List screen · · · ③


After selecting the images, click the [Download] button.

4. Number of images selected and total file size · · · ④

This part shows the number of images selected and the total file size.

*The information is as of the point the current screen was displayed. Changes made on the current screen are not included.

4 Download List Screen



On the Download List screen, you can check and download the images that are selected.

1. Cancel selection of image · · · ①

Clicking the [Cancel] button will remove the image from the download list.

2. Back ... 2

Clicking the [Back] button will return you to the Result screen or the Images List screen.

If you wish to add an image, return to the previous page with this button to select it.

3. Execute download · · · ③

Clicking the [Download] button will start download.

Selected images are compressed to a ZIP file when downloaded.

*Download may take time depending on the number of images and environment.

4. About Using Image Data · · · ④

Clicking the [About Using Image Data] button will open the PDF file of the guidelines for using images

of archive materials.



5 Image Description Screen

You can download the image that is displayed on the Image Description screen.



1. Execute download · · · ①

Clicking the [Download] button will download the image that is currently displayed.

The image is compressed to a ZIP file when downloaded.

Clicking the [About Using Image Data] button will open the PDF file of the guidelines for using images of archive materials.
