

## 「ペリー自筆書翰」

New York January 8th, 1823

Sir

A fever indispositon which has confined me to my room for several days has prevented me from calling on you in relation to my last conference with the Prests. of the insurance companies of this city. I made known to them your willingness to facilitate their wishes in respect to the Shark. They appeared gratified. And Mr. Nelson who is the public correspondent informed me that he would write to the Secy. in behalf of the office in hopes that it would be a further induement to the Dept. to dispose of the vessel as they wished.

I understand from Capt. Rodgers that you have given directions to ship the new entrees for the Shark in the Grandport.

I respectfully request that you will give just instructions as to prevent them being sent to any other vessel.

They have been particularly selected and are essentially necessary to complete the efficiency of my crew. Mr. Benham who belongs to my vessel, and who proceeds to join her immedediately. I had intended to have sent with them. I shall give him direction to report himself to you.
