Useful for:

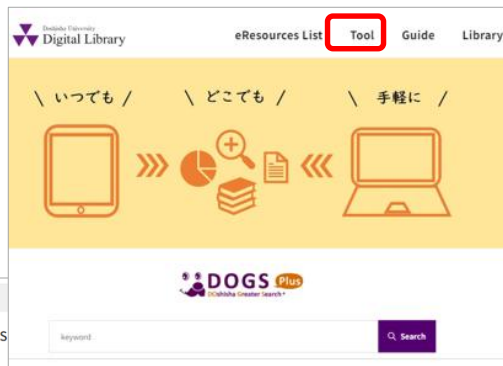
- Searching only among the electronic journals or books available on campus

Searching Resources

Discovery Service: DOGS Plus

Link List: Electronic Journals·Electronic Books

Link to this tool

Allows users to search both electronic and printed materials at one time. As the search results include citation information without full text, it does not necessarily lead you to a material with full text availability. Useful for searching a wide range of materials.

Citation Linker

Useful when you know the citation information of the materials that are available in full text.

You can use the service via the "Tool" page of the Digital Library.

I. How to Search



① Limit the type of resource

You can select the type of resource to search from "All," "Journals Only," "Books Only," and "Videos Only."

*The type of resource you select here will be reflected in the search results of ②, ③ and ④.

② Search by Title or ISSN/ISBN

■ Search by Title

You can search for an electronic journal or an electronic book by title. Enter the title in the search box and click the Search button.

★ Search Tips

- Select the search condition from the pull-down menu.
- "Title begins with "
- "Title equals "
- "Title contains all words"

*You cannot search by the title of an article or a paper.

■ Search by ISSN/ISBN

You can search by ISSN/ISBN. Select "ISSN/ISBN equals" from the pull-down menu, enter the ISSN/ISBN in the search box and click the Search button.

③ Browse by the first letter of a title

You can browse by the first letter of the title of an electronic journal or book. Click the first letter of the title.

④ Browse by subject

You can browse by subject category. Select a subject category you want to browse from the pull-down menu.

⑤ Search by database list / publisher site

This is the list of publishers and databases subscribed by the university that provide electronic journals and books. Clicking a link will redirect you to the corresponding provider website or database, where you can search for the item you need.

⑥ Search by some appropriate citation information (Citation Linker)

You can check the availability of full text by entering the citation information.

Click the radio button for the type of resource you look for. Enter citation information according to the requirements for each resource type, and click the **Find it** button.

★How to search for an article

● Search by DOI/PubMed ID (PMID)

Enter relevant information in either the “DOI” or “PMID” search box and click **Find it** button. This allows you to find the exact article you look for.

● Search by Journal Title/ISSN

Either “Journal Title” or “ISSN” must be entered. Enter "Article Title," "Author (surname)," "Author (first)," "Volume," "Issue," "Page" and "Date" as much as you know, and

***You cannot search just by the title of an article or a paper.**

Searching with the method described in ⑥ will redirect you to Article Linker.

2. Search Results

<Electronic Journal>

A Title

Link to the journal

Journal title is displayed.

B Citation information

ISSN is displayed.

C Look up Article

Clicking here will open the Citation Linker page in "I. How to search: ⑥"

D Journal Details

Click "Journal Details" to display more details of the journal.

E Peer Reviewed

This mark indicates the journal is peer-reviewed.

F Date range / Link to journal

The available date range of / link to the journal is displayed. Clicking the link will redirect you to the corresponding page for the journal.

G Search within journal

Here you can search for articles and papers within this journal.

Searching with the method (G) will redirect you to DOGS Plus.

<Electronic Book>

H Title

Book title is displayed.

I Citation information

Author, ISBN, publisher, year of publication etc. are displayed.

J Link to journal

Clicking the link will redirect you to the corresponding page for the book.
